- 2) Habakkuk stopped to listen and write down the revelation. What is God saying to you?
- 3) One of the most quoted verses from Habakkuk is verse 2:4: "...but the righteous (or just) will live by faith." What does this verse mean to you? (See also Romans 3:23-26.)
- 4) How has God used "a dip" to draw you closer to Him?
